Chester Chet Malins was from Chicago Illinois he attended Key High School here at Michigan Malins was a clarinet soloist worked in Aston Hall was a star member of Michigan's varsity track team and was active in the music fraternity of Phi Mu Alpha Malins also played in the Michigan band and orchestra and was a member of the College All-star band that played at Soldier Field Outside of school Malins was active in a Decatur dance band where he played clarinet saxophone oboe and English horn Malins graduated from Michigan in 1945 shortly before his graduation Malins signed Msw Dr. N
